## RECENT SAILING EVENTS

### Super Saturday, the 13<sup>th</sup> of July

There isn't really room in this newsletter to report on all the StMSC sailing events which have been happening recently but it is interesting to focus on one extraordinarily busy afternoon. Nine Marieholms, four of the 18 Foot Restricted Class and two IODs were competing in their annual Championships in the Carrick Roads – they sailed in a total of five races over the weekend and the eventual class winners (respectively) were Charles Warren's *Tringa*, Bob Edwards' *Magpie* and Mike Conlin's *Wild Goose*. Meanwhile, twelve St Mawes One Designs celebrated the class's 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary by competing in a race which started and finished on the club line – the winner was Nick Leach's *Buccaneer*. Furthermore the last races of a Junior Sail Training series that began in April took place off St Mawes – a total of around thirty children (and a few adults) competed in the series of thirty five races which was won by Rachel Thomas who was awarded the Brenda Pye Cup. And to cap that, two of the St Mawes-based Falmouth Working Boats went over to Flushing to compete in a race there.

### Ajax South West Championships

Eighteen boats sailed in seven races over three days, in mostly very blustery conditions. The winner was David Liddington's *Athena* followed by David Matthewson's *Ajax* and John Howard's *Aeolus*.

### Club cruise (to Fowey?!)

After several weeks of extremely calm and settled weather, the day our cruising boats were due to go to Fowey produced a strong easterly wind and big seas in the Channel. Mindful of the forecast, two boats had sensibly gone up there three days earlier but, on the day, the crews of three others decided that Mylor was a much more realistic option!
