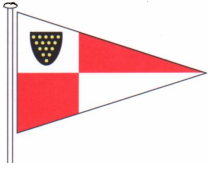


RS Feva Open Training and Racing Weekend

For those of you who haven't been to St Mawes before, the Sailing Club is on a split site, with the Club House in the centre of the village adjacent to the Town Quay, and the Sailing Club Quay (for launching boats) on the river on the main road into St Mawes, down a lane on the left, after the second turning to Freshwater Lane (TR2 5AW).
