

Using Club Sailing Dinghies

- Club dinghies can be used for:
- Club Racing
- Village Regattas
- Falmouth Week
- Junior Race Week
- Junior Regatta

If you want to use a club dinghy for Thursday evening or Sunday morning club racing you must have reached RYA Level 4 with the club and/or Bob Hindmarsh has stated you are ready to race. Be on Stoneworks Quay by 17:30 Thursdays or 09:30 Sundays.

- Let Bob Hindmarsh know you want to use the boat **before** you go. It is not often that advance booking is required but it is worth checking just in case lots of people want to use boats.
- Ensure you and your crew are on the Race Authorised list. If you are not already on the list, contact the JST instructors or Bob Hindmarsh as soon as possible. A minimum RYA Stage 4 or equivalent competency is usually needed to be signed off as a helm but crews can have less experience.
- Ensure that club safety boats are afloat and crewed before launching.
- Tell Bob Hindmarsh if anything breaks or any repairs are required.

Obviously, sailors on JST courses use club boats without any of the above requirements. JST boats may also be used for JST staff training from time to time but care will be taken to ensure this doesn't clash with any of the above events.
