

## Notice of Race

### Percuil Regatta Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2017

1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules Of sailing 2017-2020 unless changes are stated below. Class rules will apply to any applicable class.
2. The organising authority is St Mawes Sailing Club
3. **The start times** are as below

4. **Entry** forms will be available on the day from 13.30hrs and a late entry boat will be available on the water from 15.00hrs, the entry fees are £5 per adult helm and £2 per under 18 helm. Signed consent from parent or guardian is required for all helm and crew under the age of 16. Entry forms are also available from the POFSA website

5. **Courses** area will be the Percuil river to St Mawes and out in to the Carrick Roads, the courses are as per the sailing instructions.
6. **Safety**, A helm and crew are entirely responsible for their own safety whether afloat or ashore and nothing whether in the notice of race, sailing instructions or anywhere ashore reduces this responsibility. It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the condition in which she finds herself. By launching or going to sea the boat confirms she is fit for those conditions and they and their crew are competent in them. The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular third party insurance to the sum on £2,000,000 minimum. Competitors under the age of 18 must wear an approved buoyancy aid whilst afloat which is suitable for their size. Wet or dry suits are not adequate personal buoyancy.
7. **Prizes**, If there are 5 or more entries for any class for which a special race has not been arranged, they shall start in the appropriate class but will be treated as a separate class for prizes. 5 or more boats are needed to make a class any less and they will be put in the appropriate handicap class.
8. **Handicap** classes will be run using the latest Portsmouth Yardstick list
