The Lugo Challenge

Rules:

1. The Lugo Challenge can be undertaken at any time during the club's racing season – i.e. from the date of the first Spring Pursuit race to the date of the last Autumn Pursuit.
2. The course is from the club line, round the St Mawes South Cardinal buoy (the Lugo) to port or to starboard, and back to the club line.
3. It is the responsibility of competing skippers to ensure they avoid the Lugo rock itself.
4. Elapsed times will be taken by a crew member on board each competing boat. The crew member must be positioned in the same part of the boat when crossing the start line as when crossing the finish line.
5. After completion of the Challenge, skippers must fill in the form below and hand it in to the main clubhouse: either to Graham Pinkney at the office, or to a member of the bar staff.
6. Skippers/boats may undertake it as many times during the season as they want.
7. Prizes will be awarded at the annual prizegiving to the overall winner and also to various other categories or classes.
